- TRAC received final grant to make up the \$450 thousand needed for the Brickyard Landing project

**Grant Applications**

Chad reports success with grants, although it was still unofficial:

1. Barrett Avenue: \$600,000 from CCTA for bike lanes
2. Nevin Ave: \$2.6 million for the 19<sup>th</sup>-27<sup>th</sup> Street section; \$1.3 million for station work

Nancy reported that Tony Norris (City Parks) has applied for Prop 84 Sustainable Communities funding to acquire land at 16<sup>th</sup> Street and the Greenway
